BE IT RESOLVED: That the Board of County Commissioners concur in the propsed award of a contract for the construction of Oklahoma Federal Aid Secondary Project No. WER-S(1) to said low bidder: E. E. Barber Constr. Co.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Department of Highway of the State of Oklahoma is hereby authorized to expend as much of the Farm-to-Market funds derived from HB 470 of the Twentieth Legislature and HB 253 of the Twenty-First Legislature and allocated to Tulsa County as are necessary to obtain Federal participation and to process and construct said project in accordance with plans, specifications and estimates furnished by Tulsa County.
