Harris said Carr would have to be contacted to see if we have money Management available for a \$7,000 grant to assist in re-stocking the law library.

The Board recommended that Grimm contact Smith and advise him to send a letter from the Trustees of the law library stating their needs and send it to the BOCC.

Leroy Jones was present to request salary adjustments for the employees of Management Information Systems. As directed by the chairman, Jones presented a salary survey and other information to support his request.

Following discussion with Jones and the other division directors who were present, the Board concurred they would like to explore ways to perhaps give raises to all of the Board employees.

Dick volunteered to meet with division directors and form a committee to review spending and try to develop cost savings methods in each division. Recommendations will be presented to the Board when the study is completed.

The Board suspended Jones' request for 60 days or until the above study is completed.

Richard Bales requested Board approval to enter into an agreement with Tri-County Vo-Tech to provide park division employees with a formal 3-day training session in proper operation and maintenance of equipment at a cost of \$35.00 per employee for 60 employees.

Motion by Dick, seconded by Selph, to approve Bales' request at a total cost not to exceed \$2,100. Upon roll call: Selph, yes; Dick, yes; Harris, yes. Motion carried. (Clerk's Misc File No. 141397)

The Board discussed rescheduling of the October 7th BOCC meeting. Commissioners Dick and Harris will not be available to attend that meeting. The Chairman was authorized to handle the subject with the guidance of Dick Blakeley of the district attorney's office.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:40 a.m.
