The hearing on the petition of Harry Drebing and others for the creation of a water improvement district was fully considered.

There were filed petitions of Sand Springs Home and H. A. Baker to exclude certain properties in said proposed district.

The hearing on the petition of Harry Drebing and others for the creation of a water improvement district was duly considered and after such hearing the following resolution was presented by Greer who moved its adoption. Mortley seconded the motion. The vote on the resolution was: Gray, Aye; Morley, Aye; Greer, Aye. The resolution was declared adopted.

RESOLUTION

This being the day heretofore fixed for the consideration of the proceedings establishing a water improvement district pursuant to the petition of Harry Drebing and others, the Board of County Commissioners being fully advised and having heard all who have presented protests, objections, or petitions regarding the formation of said improvement district, hereby finds and determines that on the petition of the owners of the following lands, namely:

All of that land situated in Sections Three (3), Nine (9), and Ten (10), of Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Eleven (11) East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, lying within and with boundaries as follows, to-wit: All of Charles Page Home Acres Subdivision No. Two, all of Charles Page Home Acres Subdivision No. One except Block Four (4), all of Hall's First Addition to Sand Springs, all of Hall's Garden Addition to Sand Springs, that part of the South Half $(S_2^{\frac{1}{2}})$ of the Northwest Quarter $(NW_4^{\frac{1}{4}})$ of Section Ten (10) lying North of the North right-of-way line of the county highway, and all of the remaining portion of the North Half $(N_2^{\frac{1}{2}})$ of the Southeast Quarter $(SE_4^{\frac{1}{4}})$ of Section Ten (10) lying North and East of the North right-of-way line of the county highway and the East one-half $(E_2^{\frac{1}{2}})$ of the Southwest One Quarter $(SW_4^{\frac{1}{4}})$ of the Southeast One Quarter $(SE_4^{\frac{1}{4}})$ of Section Four (4), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Eleven (11) East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and less the following described property: Lots Ten (10) and Eleven (11) in Block Two (2), Hall's Garden Addition to Sand Springs, and Lot Nine (9) in Block Ten (10) and Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3) and Four (4) in Block Eleven (11) in Charles Page Home Acres Subdivision No. Two.
