R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, plans, specifications and estimates for the public distribution system in Water Improvement District Number 5, of Tulsa County, Oklahoma have been prepared and filed with this Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Resolution of the Board of Directors of said Water Improvement District approving said plans, specifications and estimates, has been published in the manner and form and for the time required by law; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, that the plans, specifications and estimates as approved by the Board of Directors of said Water Improvement District be and the same are hereby approved by this Board of County Commissioners, and that it be and is hereby found and decreed that the proposed work in said Water Improvement District is proper and necessary to be done. Said Board of Directors are hereby authorized to proceed with the letting of the contract for the construction of the improvements in accordance with the plans, specifications, and estimates and in the manner prescribed by law.

NOW, On this 24th. day of Nov. 1925, J S Shaver, Chairman, W L North and Ed W Hedgecock, Members of said Board of County Commissioners, comes the Broken Arrow Coal Company, and presents to the said Board its request in writing setting forth that it is necessary for the purpose of carrying on its business of mining and stripping coal, as in said petition stated, to lay, construct and maintain lines of pipe along and across the highway between Section 14 and 23, and 13 and 24, Township 18, Range 14 E in said Tulsa County, and said Board being fully advised in the matter and having carefully considered the same it is hereby ordered that the said Broken Arrow Coal Company be, and it is hereby permitted to lay, maintain and operate lines of pipe for the conveyance of water along and across the above described highways in said Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma.
