In the matter of Road Petition of Furr, Brown & Orey it was laid over until they could file Bond for costs. In the matter of the Petition of M. J. Mc Nulty for road this petition was granted and the following viewers were appointed to view said road John Furr, E. L. Esley & Mr Whitney the same to be advertised according to law.
