

Street and Admiral Boulevard - all to be known as Service Line, City of Tulsa.

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS,
TULSA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA.

Your Petitioner, the Oklahoma Natural Gas Company of Tulsa, Oklahoma, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Oklahoma, hereby petitions and makes application to your Honorable Body for permission to construct along and under the above specified public highway of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, its twelve inch intermediate pressure gas pipe line known as Service Line City of Tulsa and respectfully shows and represents to your Honorable Body as follows:

1. That it is a Corporation duly incorporated and existing under and by virtue of the Laws of the State of Oklahoma, having its principal office and place of business at Tulsa, Oklahoma, and has complied with all the laws, rules and regulations provided by the laws of the State of Oklahoma to authorize and enable it to engage in and transact business in the State of Oklahoma, and is engaged in the business of purchasing, producing, marketing and conveying natural gas in the State of Oklahoma.
2. That under and by virtue of the Articles of Association and Incorporation and the Laws of the State of Oklahoma, it is authorized to engage in and conduct, and is engaged in conducting the business of purchasing, producing, marketing, transporting and conveying natural gas in the State of Oklahoma, and it is desirous of constructing its said gas pipe line to further advance its said business in Tulsa County, Oklahoma.
3. That it cannot put down its said gas pipe line without the consent and permission of this Honorable Board to use said highways, and in order to complete its said twelve inch intermediate pressure gas pipe line it is necessary for it to have the power and authority to construct said line above mentioned along and under the specified public highway of said County.
4. That in putting down said gas pipe line this Company will comply with all the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing the construction and operation of same, and will likewise comply with all the rules and regulations provided by this Board or other competent authority of the State of Oklahoma, for the construction and operation of same.
5. Your petitioner submits as a part of this, its petition, a blue print map showing the definite location of its said twelve inch intermediate pressure gas pipe line known as Service Line - City of Tulsa.

WHEREFORE, Your Petitioner respectfully requests that it be authorized and empowered to put down, lay, construct, maintain and operate this said gas pipe line for the conveyance of natural gas along and under the said specified public highway of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, under such rules and regulations as may in the judgement of your Honorable Body be necessary for the protection and preservation of said Highway, to avoid any inconvenience to the public in the use of the same, and for the protection of said County against liability for damage by reason of the construction, maintenance, and operation of the same.

Now, on this 5th. day of July, A.D. 1923, at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County Oklahoma, held in compliance with and according to law, the application of the OKLAHOMA NATURAL GAS COMPANY, a corporation of Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the right to put down, construct, and operate its twelve inch intermediate pressure gas pipe line known as Service line, City of Tulsa, along and under the above specified public highway of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, which application is in writing and sets forth that it is necessary for the purpose of further advancing the business of said Company in the purchasing, producing, marketing, transporting and conveying of natural gas as in said petition stated, to lay, construct, operate and maintain said pipe line along and under the specified public highway of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, comes on to be considered and said Board after hearing said application and considering same and being fully advised in the premises finds that said application should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, That the Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, be and the same is hereby authorized and empowered to lay, put down, construct and maintain and operate this its gas pipe line for the conveyance transmission and transportation of natural gas along and under the said specified public highway of Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That said gas pipe line be buried so as not to interfere with the ingress and egress of adjacent farmers at the ordinary places of entrance to their lands and at such other places along said highway where abutting land owners may desire to locate a place for entrance to their lands when so requested by the owners.

IT IS UNDERSTOOD, That in granting this order it shall be in nowise construed as assuming any responsibility on the part of the Board of Commissioners of said County, or on the part of the said County, for any damage arising from the putting down, construction, and operation of said line, but the Oklahoma Natural Gas Company shall be responsible for all damage accruing from the construction of said gas pipe line or which in any wise may be caused or occasioned thereby or by the use of the same.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED, That this order and the rights accrued hereunder and granted hereby shall in nowise abridge the right or authority of the County Commissioners, the Township Trustees, and the Road Overseers of the public highways in said County as the same is now provided by law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That said line shall be so used, made and constructed as not to interfere with the use of said public highway, nor the repair thereof, nor with the drainage of the highways, and in crossing streams and drains, it shall be placed above or below the same so as not to obstruct the flow of water therein, and when placed under the surface of highways, the surface or roadbed thereof shall be restored to the same degree of safety for travel as the same was before said pipe line was put under the surface thereof.
