Gentlemen:

Your representative has made application to the Tulsa County Commissioners for permission to install a power pole line along Mud Creed Road upon the Tulsa County Right-of-Way through the following described lands:

"The Southeast Quarter of Section 15, Town-ship 19 North, Range 10 East and the North-west Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 22, Township 19 North, Range 10 East."

Tulsa County has a Right-of-Way width through portions of the above described lands of 66 feet. It is recommended that the center line of your pole line be not more than 12 inches to the closest side of the Right-of-Way line you choose to follow. A sketch of this Right-of-Way and its location is attached hereto.
