Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the bond filed by Jim E. Miller, appointed Constable in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, in the amount of \$1,000 be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the annual report filed by the Tulsa State Fair, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that an easement be given to the ^{State of Oklahoma,} ~~Sixty of Sand Springs~~ on Lots 3 and 18, Block 3, McKellops Addition to the City of Sand Springs for the purpose of enabling the State Highway Department to cross the property during the construction work necessary for the protection of the south bank of the Arkansas River, West of Sand Springs bridge. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
