DESIGNATING THE COUNTY ENGINEER TO PREPARE THE NECESSARY PLANS AND PROFILES AND TO PROCEED WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE FAVING OF THAT PORTION OF UNPAVED HIGHWAY LYING IN TULSA COUNTY NORTH OF THIRTY FIRST STREET AND SOUTH OF THE MIDLAND VALLEY RAILROAD COMPANY'S RIGHT OF WAY ON RIVERSIDE DRIVE IN SECTION 13-TOWNSHIP 19 N-RANGE 12 E.

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary and to the best interests of Tulsa County, that said roadway be paved 20' in width, using what is commonly called Bates Type 7-10-7 concrete paving.

AND WHEREAS, it is desired by the Board of County Commissioners that said work proceed as soon as possible so that the traveling public of Tulsa County can receive the benefits from said improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County that the County Engineer is hereby instructed and directed to proceed with said improvements and to make whatever necessary arrangements can be made to procure WPA or any other Federal assistance that can be procured for said Tulsa County, and proceed with the construction of said pavement to its completion.
