R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, on then23rd. day of April 1928, a Contract was entered into by and between Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and Roy Tanner Paving Co., for the paving of certain highways.

AND, WHEREAS, the above mentioned contract recites, that when mutually agreed to by and between the County Board and the Contractor, the contract may be considered for extension to additional work of the same character.

AND, WHEREAS, ROY TANNER PAVING COMPANY has agreed to pave (1) One Mile between Sections Thirty Two (32) and Thirty Three (33), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Thirteen (13) East; same being Mile 1 of Section "KK" Tulsa County Highway, at the same prices which prevail in the original contract no. 192 and under the same specifications; said work to be done immediately.

AND, WHEREAS, it is considered to be for the best interest of Tulsa County to accept the above agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That Contract No 192 be and the same is hereby extended to include the paving of the above described mile.
