WHEREAS, Tulsa County has this day 1,000 bales of hay that is not needed,
and

WHEREAS, it is to the best interests of Tulsa County Farm that the same
be disposed of, and

WHEREAS, Tulsa County Farm is in need of ground feed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners that the Superintendent of Tulsa County Farm be authorized to trade 1,000 bales of hay @ 20¢ per bale to the Tulsa Feed Company for an equal amount of ground feed.
