Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners met at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A. M., with all members present: Roy Evans, Chairman; Claude W. Bailey and John Couch, Members. William P. Gable, Jr., County Clerk.

Roy Evans, Chairman, presiding, the following official business was transacted:

Motion made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, and unanimously carried, that the Excise Board be requested to meet with the Commissioners for a rehearing on their decision concerning the County Budget.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried that the form of application and permit to be used in connection with applications to cut roads and pavements, as suggested by the County Engineer, be and the same is hereby approved, and the proposed form filed for future reference.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that the final estimate due the Pate Engineer Company for preparation of plans, specifications, etc., for the construction of the new Jenks-Arkansas River Bridge, in the amount of \$440.98, be, and the same is hereby approved for payment.

Motion made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that Claude W. Bailey be, and he is hereby elected as Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners. All Commissioners voting in the affirmative, said motion is declared carried and Commissioner Bailey is elected Chairman of this Board.

Motion made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that an audit be made of the County Engineer's Office for the purpose of determining the allotment of the various funds in the three Districts.

Motion made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that all the heads of the different County Departments be ready for ratification Monday morning. Motion carried.
