Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners re-convened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: G. H. Shepard, Chairman; Ralsa F. Morley and Lincoln Sallee, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

G. H. Shepard, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

The minutes of May 8th, 13th and 20th were read and there being no objection to the same, motion was made by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that they stand approved as read. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Morley, Aye; Sallee, Aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by the County Assessor covering realestate for the year 1939 (Lot 3, Blk. 1, Reservoir View Addition and Sub. Blk. 3, Acre), ^{Gardens} be and the same is hereby approved and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue a certificate of error covering same. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Morley, Aye; Sallee, Aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Shepard, that a quit claim be issued to Bennie Donahou covering the E $\frac{1}{2}$ Lot 5 and all Lot 6, Block 15, O.T. of Collinsville, for the reason that said property was sold in error to Tulsa County; application for homestead exemption having been allowed by the County Assessor, according to Joe T. Parkinson, County Treasurer, and the Chairman is hereby authorized to execute said deed. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Morley, Aye; Sallee, Aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Sallee, that a recess be taken until Wednesday, June 12th, 1940, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M. Motion carried.
