It is further agreed that at the end of the 1933 baseball season second party shall have title to and the right to remove all fixtures not made permanent such as fence built for enclosing field, lights and any box seats, chairs or reserve chair seats install ed, and that at the expiration of the 1933 baseball season, second party will put that part of the race track used as a playing field back in the same condition it was before any improvements were made, and to replace and repair any fence removed or damaged and to remove the playing field fence and any other obstruction erected, all of this to be done prior to the opening of the Tulsa State Fair in September, 1933.

It is further agreed that second party shall have the first option to again contract for the use of the Tulsa State Fair Grounds for the purpose of playing baseball provided the party of the first part decides to lease the above mentioned premises for baseball purposes for 1934.

The covenants and agreements of this contract shall extend to and be binding upon the successors and assigns of the parties hereto.
