 animously carried, that the following Resolution be, and the same is hereby adopted:

RESOLUTION

Now, on this 7th day of August, 1950, there comes on for  
 hearing the petition of 12 freeholders residing in the vicinity  
 of the road affected, requesting this Board to establish, open  
 and lay out a public road 100 feet in width, located in Sections  
 7, 8 and 18, Twp. 19 N. Range 12 E., Tulsa County, Oklahoma,

Beginning approximately .75 of a mile West of the  
 Northeast corner of Section 17, Township 19 North,  
 Range 12 East, in Tulsa County, thence West  $1\frac{1}{2}$   
 miles along the South side of the Arkansas River,  
 completing the highway from 21st Street to U. S.  
 64 Highway at the Sand Springs bridge,

as set forth and delineated in plans on file in the office of the  
 County Engineer and County Clerk;

And it appearing that the petition is in all respects  
 sufficient, and that a public hearing thereon should be had;

NOW, THEREFOR, BE IT RESOLVED that said petition be, and  
 is hereby set for hearing before the Board of County Commissioners  
 of Tulsa County on the 30th day of August, 1950, at 10:00 A. M.,  
 at which time said petition will be acted upon, and that due and  
 proper notice of said hearing be given to the public by the County  
 clerk for 20 days prior to said hearing by publishing in the Tulsa  
 Daily Legal News.
