Pursuant to adjournment of Monday, July 16, 1923, the Board of County Commissioners met, but no business was transacted other than the signing of the Memorandum of Agreement which is herewith given in detail:

Memorandum of Agreement for Farm and Home Demonstration work between the County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and the Oklahoma A & M College Extension Division, in co-operation with the United State Department of Agriculture. States Relation Service.

This instrument entered into this 13th. day of July, 1923, is to witness that the above commissioners agree to co-operate with the Extension Division of the Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical College and the U.S.Department of Agriculture in conducting Farm and Home Demonstration work in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, during the year 1923-1924, under the following terms:

The County Commissioners agree to pay Two Hundred Twenty Five Dollars (\$225.) per month on the salary of an Agent in charge of Farm Demonstration work for a period of twelve months, beginning July 1, 1923;

And the County Commissioners agree to pay One Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$120.00 per month on the salary of a Home Demonstration Agent for a period of Twelve Months, beginning July 1st. 1923.

And, the County Commissioners agree to pay Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.) per month on the salary of an Assistant County Farm Demonstration Agent to work under the supervision of the County Agent for a period of Twelve Months, beginning July 1st. 1923.

And the County Commissioners agree further to put up the following amounts to apply on the expense, equipment and maintenance of County Agent's work as carried on in this County for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 1923; Twenty Five Hundred Dollars (\$2500.) for County Agent's office; Fourteen Hundred Dollars (\$1400) expense account of Home Demonstration Agent; twenty five hundred Dollars (\$2500) on expense of Assistant County Farm Agent's work; and Eighteen Hundred (\$1800.) Dollars for office help.

The Extension Division of the Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical College, co-operating with the U.S.Department of Agricultural, shall select the agents and shall pay One Hundred Ten Dollars (\$110.) per month on the salary of the Farm Demonstration Agent, and they will also pay One Hundred Ten Dollars (\$110.) per month on the salary of the Home Demonstration Agent, furnish them with the franking privilege, stationery, literature and instructions. The Extension Division shall superintend the work of the Agents; and pay their expenses when duly authorized to make trips outside of the County on official business.

The Agents' salaries shall be payable on or after the first of each month on certificate from the extension Division of the A & M College that the work has been duly performed.

The Extension Division of the Oklahoma A & M College agrees to furnish to the Assistant County Agent, stationery and supplies and to supervise his work through the County Agent.

This Agreement shall be in force for twelve months beginning, July 1st. 1923.
