## SPECIFICATIONS

SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF DRAINAGE STRUCTURES UNDER THE MIDLAND VALLEY RAILROAD AT STAION 782-19, MIDLAND VALLEY STATION MAP.

- 1. All plans referred to in these Specifications are according to blue print herewith attached and becoming a part thereof.
- 2. The Specifications referred to are Oklahoma State Highway Standard Specification for highway construction as of July 1st, 1932.
- 3. Before the beginning of any construction on the property of the Midland Valley Rail-road Company, said company will construct, according to their plans and specifications, the necessary bridge or tresle for the sage conveyance of the railroad's rollong stock over the opening required during the construction of ditch and drainage structure.
- 4. The drainage structure shall consist of three lines of re-inforced concrete pipe of sufficient length to extend through the fill under the railroad a sufficient distance to hold the fill above as shown on plans.

Pipe shall be placed according to Oklahoma State Highway Specifications Section 84, Paragraph 94.11, 84.12, 84.13, Pages 159 and 160.

- 5. The fill to be made on top of structure after placing shall be made according to Cklahoma State Highway Specifications, Section 10, Paragraph 10.10, Page 37.
- 6. The drainage ditch across the property of the Midland Valley Railroad shall be of sufficient width on the bottom to carry the maximum amount of drainage to said pipe, said slopes to be 2' in 1' and shall be riprapped from the bottom of the ditch to the top of bank in such a manner as to present any erosion of railroad company's property and said riprap shall be land according to Oklahoma State Highway Specifications, Section 102, Paragraph 102.01, 102.02, Page 200.
- 7. All construction of said drainage structures and ditch lying on the property of the Midland Valley shall be under the supervision of the Chief Engineer of the Midland Valley Railroad Company or his representatives.
- S. The County covenants and agrees that all and every part of said work and labor shall be done in the best and most workmanlike manner and that all and every part of said materials and labor shall be in strict and entire conformity in every respect with said specifications and plans and shall be subject to the inspection and approval of the "Engineer" in charge of said work or his duly authorized assistants, and in case of any of said materials or labor shall be rejected by the Engineer or his assistants as defective or unsuitable, then the said materials shall be removed and replaced with other approved materials and the said labor shall be done at the expense of the County.
