R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary that contract be entered into between the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County and the Midland Valley Railroad Company, for the erection of a temporary trestle in the S.E. 1/4 of Section 30-Township 17-Range 14, Tulsa County, the same to be used to carry the Midland Valley Railroad Company's tracks during the construction of a drainage ditch under the same and placing of three concrete pipes under the same.

AND WHEREAS, the County of Tulsa has deposited with the Midland Valley Railroad Company the sum of One Thousand and Fifty Dollars, (\$1,050.00) and the Midland Valley Railroad Company is now ready to construct said temporary bridge.
