O R D E R

NOW, on this the 27th. day of October, 1930, the application of Kate C. Fulghum, doing business under the name of Conway-Broun School, for the correction of the erroneous assessment of the

East 100 feet of Lot 6, in Block 1, and Lot No.1, Block 2 of Burgess Hill Addition to the City of Tulsa, according to the official plat thereof,

because said property is exempt from taxation, because used exclusively for school or educational purposes, comes on regularly to be heard before the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, regularly convened, and the applicant offering to introduce testimony in support of the allegations of her application, the offer of testimony is refused, and the application considered upon the statement of facts therein contained, and the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, having considered the same, finds that even if the statement of facts contained in said application is true, that said property is used for private profit and is not exempt.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ordered that the application of Kate C Fulghum, doing business under the name of CONWAY -BROUN SCHOOL forthe correction of the assessment on said above described property, be DISALLOWED, for the reason that said property is not exempt.

IN THE MATTER OF LAYING A TELEPHONE LINE :
UNDER,THROUGH,ACROSS AND ALONG CERTAIN :
HIGHWAYS: :

Comes now, the Southwestern Natural Gas Company, a company organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Delaware, with offices in Tulsa, Oklahoma, and hereby petitions your Honorable Board for the right to erect, construct, maintain and operate a telephone line over, across and along certain highways; said telephone line to be used in conjunction with the gas pipe line of the petitioner, for the construction of which your Honorable Board has previously given its permission.

Said telephone line to begin at a point 1147 feet West and 33 feet South of the Southwest corner of the Southwest Quarter of Sectionn8, Twp 19, Range 12, and running thence East along a line parallel to and 33 feet South of the center line of Twenty First Street, approximately 660 feet.

The Petitioner will construct and maintain said telephone line so as not to interfere with rights of the general public, and will, at all times keep said telephone line in a good state of repair.

The Petitioner further agrees to make such changes in said telephone line as are ordered by the proper authorities of such county when it is necessary for the construction, improvement or repair of the publichighway over, across and along which said line is located.

Furthermore, petitioner agrees to comply with all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma in the construction of said telephone line.
