## ORDER

NOW, on this the 27th. day of October, 1930, the matter of the petition of MARY C UNVERFERTH, Route 11, Box 88, Tulsa, Oklahoma, for permission to lay a pipe line along the right of way paralleling a certain County Highway came up before the Board of County Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board and each of the Commissioners thereof that it was just that the said Mary C Unverferth be permitted to use as much of the highway as designated by the following description:

Beginning at the Southwest (SW) corner of the E½ of the W¼ of SW¼ of Section Three (3) Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, at a point on the road right of way; and running thence East approximately One Thousand (1000') feet, paralleling the County Highway with a Two (2) inch gas line, to a connection with a line owned by the Oklahoma Natural Gas Corp".

AND, it further appearing from the petition herein that said pipe line will be so constructed as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highway; and will be constructed in accordance with all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing same.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the Board of County Commissioners of said County, that permission be granted, and the same is hereby granted to MARY C UNVERFERTH, her heirs and assigns, to use as much of the highway as above designated.

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Board of County Commissioners of said County said hereinabove describedreal estate is not needed and is unsuited for such highway purposes. And it is further resolved and declared that said real property is not needed for Court House or Jail purposes, or for other County purposes.
