And it further appearing from the petition herein that said water line will be so constructed as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said right of ways; and will be constructed in accordance with all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma, governing the same.

It is hereby ordered and adjudged by the Board of County Commissioners, that permission be granted and the same is hereby granted to the Salvation Army its successors and assigns, to use the above described highways as above set out.
