McKeehan, The petition of Casper Page et al for Road in Wekiwa Township was read and on motion same was rejected as impractical, The petition of Baswell, Brown and Hill for road in Wekiwa Township was read and on motion of Board same was accepted as herein described, Beginning at a point where section line intersects Arkansas river in section 12, Township 19, Range 11 East, thence East along said river above high water mark through section 7 to section line between section 7 & 8, thence north on section line to Railroad Bridge, thence East to section line between section 5 & 8, thence East along said section line to a point where said section line intersects said river in section 4, Township 19, Range 12, East, thence East along said river above high water mark through section 4, & halfway through section 3 the point of ending The following viewers C. B. Owens, B. J. Pettus, & J. W. Near were appointed together with the County Surveyor to meet at the place of beginning on Thursday Oct. 1, "1908 at 10 A. M. to lay out and view said road.
