Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the report submitted by Water Improvement District No. 3, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that Marshall O. Hatt be and he is hereby released from the bond of G. C. Daves, Constable, from and after this the 6th day of December, 1937. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that \$3,000.00 be allocated for hospitalization for the month of December, 1937, same to be divided and allocated as follows: Morningside Hospital \$1,700; Sisler Hospital \$900; St. Johns Hospital \$100; Tulsa General Hospital \$100; Poole Hospital \$100, and Flower Hospital \$100. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Miller, Yes; Gray, Yes; Hopkins, Yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the following amounts be allocated to the following for drugs and supplies for the month of December, 1937: Red Fork \$30.00; Sperry \$25.00; Skiatook \$10.00; Dr. Smith \$50.00; Sand Springs \$25.00; Collinsville \$75.00; Bixby \$50.00; Broken Arrow \$50.00; Jenks \$25.00; Dr. Motley \$75.00; Dr. Barham \$150.00; Dr. Roberts \$50.00; Dr. McGuire \$5.00; Dr. Roberts for the jail \$100.00, for the clinic \$100.00. To the various drug stores for prescriptions, to be divided as follows: Dr. Roberts \$100.00; Dr. McGuire \$25.00; Dr. Motley \$50.00; Dr. Barham \$225.00. To Dr. Childs is allocated \$60.00 and to Dr. Hairston \$40.00 for services and supplies. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by F. M. Wooden covering a double assessment on real estate for the years 1929 to 1932, inc., be and the same is hereby approved and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue a Certificate of Error covering same. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that J. C. Chaney and F. D. Coplin, be and they are hereby employed in the Highway department as of November 8th, 1937, and V. E. Wantland be and he is hereby employed in the Highway department as of December 6th, 1937, all at a salary of \$100.00 per month each.
