RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TULSA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA.

WHEREAS, Section 1, Article 1, Chapter 35, Oklahoma Session Laws 1935 as amended by H.B. 161, Oklahoma Session Laws 1941 provides for counties to assist and cooperate with relief agencies established by the State of Okkahoma or the Federal Government.

WHEREAS, said act provides for the Board of County Commissioners to employ, subject to approval of said Public Welfare Board case workers or other employees specially fitted for relief work to aid and assist the State Board of Public Welfare in its relief work in such county and to pay such employees not to exceed One Hundred Twenty-Five (\$125.00) per month.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is further authorized to pay claims for supplies, office furniture, and fixtures, rent, water, telephone, light, fuel, material and transportation incurred in cooperation with the State Relief Administration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TULSA COUNTY, OKIAHOMA, IN OPEN REGULAR SESSION THIS THE 18 DAY OF AUGUST, 1941.

That \$5,837.50 be requested and submitted to the County Excise Board for appropriation to the following items of appropriation:

"STATE BOARD OF PUBLIC WELFARE - STAMP RELIEF PLAN"
