

FRIDAY, AUGUST 22nd, 1941.

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman; Ralsa F. Morley and Curtis Greer, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that an additional \$250.00 be allocated to the Welfare Department for groceries for the month of August, 1941. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

The minutes of July 31st up to and including August 13th, 1941, were read and there being no objection to the same, motion was made by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that they stand approved as read. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the appointment of R. L. Armitage as fee deputy sherriff as made by A. Garland Marrs, Sheriff, be and the same is hereby confirmed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the Cash Fund Estimate of Needs and Request for Appropriation for the County Highway Cash Fund in the amount of \$13,898.58, be and the same is hereby approved and the Chairman is hereby authorized to sign said request and submit same to the Excise Board for their consideration. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carroed.
