Upon motion of W. L. North which was duly seconded by F. M. Wooden the two bonds of the Collinsville National Bank, both of which were executed by the Fidelity and Deposit Company of Maryland in the amounts of \$10,000.00 and \$3,000.00 and expiring January 1st, 1922 and March 1st, 1922 respectively; together with duplicate depository bond of the First National Bank of Bixby, Oklahoma, executed by the United States Fidelity and Guaranty Company of Baltimore, Maryland, in the amount of \$25,500.00 (Twenty Five Thousand Five Hundred Dollars, for a period of one year beginning August 20th, 1920, were present to and approved by the Board of County Commissioners, by a unanimous vote.
