Wherefore your Petitioner would respectfully request that it be permitted to lay, maintain and operate lines of pipe and telegraph wire for the conveyance of crude oil or petroleum, along and across any of the public highways of Tulsa County, where the same may be necessary for the construction of its said lines of pipe and wire under such rules and regulations as may be necessary in the judgment of your Honorable Board, for the protection and preservation of said highways, and so as to avoid any inconvenience to the public in the use of same, as well as the protection of said county against liability for damages, by reason of the construction, maintainance and operation of same.

Now on this 23 day of September, 1908, at a special meeting called in compliance of and according to law, of said Board of county commissioners, comes the Prairie Oil & Gas Company and presents to the said Board its request in writing, setting forth that it is necessary for the purpose of carrying on its business of purchasing and transporting crude petroleum, as in said petition stated to lay, construct and maintain lines of pipe and telegraph or telephone wire along and across the public highways of said Tulsa County, and said Board being fully advised in the matter and having carefully considered the same, it is hereby ordered that the said Prairie Oil and Gas Co. be and it is hereby permitted to lay maintain and operate lines of pipe and telegraph or telegraph wire for the conveyance of crude oil along and across any of the public highways in said Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, where the same may be necessary for the construction of its said lines of pipe.

It is further ordered that said lines of pipe shall be buried so as not to interfere with ingress or egress to adjacent farms at the ordinary places of entrance and at such other places along such highways where the abutting land-owner may desire to locate a place for entrance when so requested by said owner.

It is understood that in granting this order that it shall in no way be construed as assuming any responsibility on the part of
