Motion was made by Mr.Hedgecock, seconded by Mr.Dickey, that the resignation of CHAS BROWN, as Justice of the Peace be and the same is hereby accepted. Carried.

Motion was made by Mr.Hedgecock, seconded by Mr.Dickey, that the Bid of W E SUNDAY for the purchase of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Ten (10), Township Twenty Two (22), Range Fourteen (14), be and the same is hereby rejected for the reason that F E CARLSTROM raised the bid of the said W E Sunday. Motion carried.

The following Resolution was introduced by Commissioner Hedgecock, who moved its adoption, and the motion to adopt being seconded by Commissioner Dickey, the Chairman ordered the Resolution read:

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, for the purpose of constructing a highway through and across certain land in Section One (1) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Fourteen (14) East, Tulsa County Oklahoma, it is necessary to acquire a strip of land particularly described as follows:

"A strip of land for public highway purposes said strip being the North forty (N 40') feet of Lots Five (5) and Six (6), Section One (1), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Fourteen (14) East, containing 2.4 acres, more or less.

AND WHEREAS, Tulsa county has been unable to affect an amicable settlement in the matter of the said strip of land owned by CURT L SEIDEMAN.

AND, WHEREAS, it is necessary to acquire said strip of land for right of way for highway purposes by condemnation proceedings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the County Attorney, in the name of this Board, for and on behalf thereof, be and he is hereby instructed to institute condemnation proceedings in the District Court of this County for the purpose of condemning said above described tract of land for highway purposes.

The vote on the motion to adopt the Resolution being in the affirmative, was declared carried.
