MONDAY, DECEMBER 20th, 1937.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, December 20th, 1937, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: John H. Miller, Chairman; J. B. Gray and Harry L. Hopkins, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

John H. Miller, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with and there being no objection to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the application for correction of erroneous assessment filed by O. Smith, Receiver, covering real estate for the years 1930, 1931 and 1932, be and the same is hereby approved and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue a Certificate of Error covering same. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried. Misc. No. 36533.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by the Petroleum Printing Company covering Corporation Tax for the years 1929, 1930, 1931 and 1932, be and the same is hereby approved and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue a certificate of error covering same. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried. Misc. No. 36535.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by Arch J. Johnson covering real estate for the years 1929 to 1932, inc., be and the same is hereby approved and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue a certificate of error covering same. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried. Misc. No. 36536.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that W. L. Boyd be and he is hereby appointed Justice of the Peace in and for the City and Township of Owasso, Oklahoma, subject to the approval of a good bond. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that Lot 14, Block 2, Crutchfield Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, be and the same is hereby leased to Mrs. L. C. Stilwell, 1417 E. King St., Tulsa, Oklahoma, ^{for one year} for the sum of \$3.00 per year. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that all County offices be requested to close, if possible, Thursday, December 23rd, 1937, at five o'clock ^{P.M.} and remain closed until Monday, December 27th, 1937, at eight o'clock A.M. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
