## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Tulsa County is indebted to HERMAN O. BURTON in the amount of \$1,050.00, with interest at 6% per annum from December 15, 1948, and court costs in the amount of \$\frac{1}{2} - \frac{1}{2}\$ by virture of a judgment rendered by the State Industrial Commission of the State of Oklahoma, and transcripted to the District Court of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, being cause No. 78,794 in said court; and

WHEREAS, an amount equivalent to two-thirds of said judgment has, by the County Treasurer, heretofore been paid to the Clerk of said District Court upon claims filed, as provided by Title 62, Section 365.5, O. S. 1941 as amended: and

WHEREAS, the County Treasurer has canvassed his Sinking Fund and has ascertained that there is in the County Sinking Fund an amount of actual cash over and above the amount of cash needed to pay all coupons and bonds maturing and matured, within the time such Sinking Fund will be replenished from revenues made or to be made for such judgment; and

WHEREAS, the County Treasurer has requested the approval by this Board of his payment to the Clerk of said Court of the balance due on said judgment, as provided by said Section 365.5, O. S., 1941, as amended, and an investment of County Sinking Fund in said judgment, as provided by Section 541, Title 62, O. S., 1941; and

WHEREAS, said judgment creditor has made an assignment to the County Treasurer of the balance so due him;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Treasurer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, be, and he is, hereby authorized to invest the County Sinking Fund in said judgment, and upon claim filed by the Clerk of the District Court to pay to mid Clerk the balance of judgment due in said Cause No. 78,794 in the amount of \$350.00 for the use and benefit of judgment creditor, HERMAN O. BURTON, or his assigns, all as per award of the State Industrial Commission as transcripted to said court.

All Commissioners voting in the affirmative said motion was by the Chairman declared carried and the Resolution adopted this 30th day of August, 1950.
