

Pipe to be used for transporting crude petroleum only.

Not to obstruct flow of water, Pipe, Telegraph, or Telephone, not to interfere repair of highway

the Board of County Commissioners of said Tulsa County, or on the part of said County, but the Prairie Oil and Gas Company shall be responsible for all damages done in constructing said lines of pipe, or which in any wise may be caused or occasioned thereby or by the use of the same hereafter. It is further agreed and understood that said lines of pipe shall be used only for the transportation of crude petroleum. It is further understood and agreed that this order and the rights secured and granted thereby shall in no wise abridge the right and of the County Commissioners, the township Trustees and the Road Overseers of the public highways in said County as the same is now provided by law.

It is further ordered that said lines of pipe, telegraph or telephone wires shall be so laid and constructed so as not to interfere with the use of any of the said public highways nor the repair thereof. When pipe, telegraph or telephone lines parallel section lines they shall be laid and constructed as near the outside line of highways as possible and in no case shall they encroach on the inside line of the highway more than three feet, without first getting permission from County Commissioners so to do.

It is further ordered that said lines of pipe shall be laid and constructed so as not to interfere with the drainage of the highways, and in crossing drains or streams shall be placed above or below the same so as not to obstruct the flow of water therin.
