Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the appointment of L. L. Elliott as fee deputy at the Spartan Air School as made by A. Garland Marrs, Sheriff, be and the same is hereby confirmed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
