Dickenson, a deed in due form of law, conveying to him the said tract of land belonging to Tulsa County aforesaid, upon payment by said Dickenson to Tulsa County of the sum of One Hundred Pollars (\$100.00), and the delivery of the deed to Tulsa County of the said tract given in exchange therefor.
