Before the Honorable Board of County Commissioners for said Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma.

Be it remembered, that on the 3rd, day of March, 1914, the following proceedings were had by the Board of County Commissioners for Tulsa County.

Whereas, Tulsa County is the owner in fee of the following described tract of land, to wit:

All that portion or part of the North one-half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 32, in Township 20 North, Range 13 East, lying north of the right of way of the St. L. & S. F. R. R. Co., containing four acres, more or less, in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, of the market value of \$400.00; and,

Whereas, W. O. Dickenson, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, is the owner of the following described tract of land, to wit:

All that portion or part of the South one-half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 32, in Township 20, North, Range 13 East, lying south of the right of way of the St. L. & S. F. R. R. Co., containing four acres, more or less in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, of the market value of \$300.00; which said latter tract lies adjacent to other land now owned by Tulsa County heretofore purchased from the Tulsa Commercial Club; and Whereas, said W. O. Dickenson has made a proposition to the Board, to exchange his said tract of land for the tract above described belonging to Tulsa County, he to pay the sum of One Hundred Dollars in cash to compensate said County for the difference in valuation of said two tracts; and, Whereas, it is the sense of this Board that said exchange will be for the benefit of Tulsa County, in that its entire holdings in that vicinity, will then be contiguous, and all lying on the same side of said Railroad;

Be it resolved, by the Board of County Commissioners that the exchange of said property be made upon the terms aforesaid, and the chairman of the Board is hereby authorized and ordered to execute to said W. O. Dickenson, a deed in due form of law, conveying to him the said tract of land belonging to Tulsa County aforesaid, upon payment by said Dickenson to Tulsa County of the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), and the delivery of the deed to Tulsa County of the said tract given in exchange therefor.
