Wagoner</u> as a Deputy Sheriff, at a salary of \$175.00 per month, effective October 15, 1944. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Gray, to accept and file letter from The University of Tulsa dated October 4, 1944, advising the Board of County Commissioners that the University does not desire to renew the lease on the N.Y.A. barracks located on the Fair Grounds for the ensuing year. All members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, that the reports filed by Cal Crum, Court Clerk, District Court Division; Andy Stokes, County Clerk, and Emile F. Sterger, Clerk Court of Common Pleas for the month of September, 1944, be accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
