

Near Broken Arrow Road petition read and viewers appointed
 Petition of Gulf Pipe Line Limited
 Wekiwa road, petition accepted,
 W. B. Williams appointed asst. Co. Atty, Road reduced to 32 ft.

Tulsa Oklahoma Oct. 5, 1908

The County Commissioners of Tulsa Co. met at 1 P. M. Present W. S. North,
 C. H. Cleveland & Geo. Mc Keenan. The petition of Kenedy Haymes & Hurd for
 road near Broken Arrow, was read and the following viewers were appointed to view
 said road W. N. Williams P. W. Mc Barry & J. A. Whitmer together with County Surveyor
 to meet on the 4 day of Nov. 1908 and lay out and view said proposed road. The report
 of viewers in the Petition of Roswell Brown & Hill for road in Wekiwa Township,
 was read and the same was accepted except that road was reduced to 32 feet in
 width. It was ordered that County Clerk be authorized to issue warrants for amount of
 damages as assessed by the board. On motion of Board W. B. Williams was appointed
 assistant County attorney as per the appointment M. A. Breshinridge Co. Attorney.
 On Motion, W. B. Williams' Assistant County Attorney, Salary was fixed at \$12.50 per
 month.

The Petition of the Gulf Pipe Line Co. for use of Highways was read and order granted
 for the use of Public highways for Pipe Line. On motion of Board W. B. Williams was instructed to
 begin correspondence with State authorities to collect proceeds of liquor seizures.

To The Honorable Board Of County Commissioners Of Tulsa County,
 State of Oklahoma.

The Petitioner, the Gulf pipe line company, would respectfully represent and
 show to your Honorable Board that it is a corporation, duly authorized and
 existing under the Laws of the State, of Texas, for the production, purchase
 and transportation of crude petroleum. That said company has complied with
 all laws, rules and regulations relating to foreign corporations, and is
 engaged in the business of purchasing and transporting crude petroleum
 in the State of Oklahoma. That it is desirous of conducting its said
 business in the County of Tulsa, and it will be necessary to construct
 various lines of pipe and telegraph and telephone wire along and across
 the highways of said County.

Wherefore your petitioners would respectfully request that it be permitted
 to lay, maintain and operate lines of pipe and telegraph wire for the
 conveyance of crude oil or petroleum, along and across any of the public
 highways of Tulsa County, where the same may be necessary for the construction
 of its said lines of pipe and wire, under such rules and regulations as
 may be necessary in the judgment of your Honorable Board for the
 protection and preservation of said highways, and so as to avoid any incon-
 venience to the public in the use of same, as well as the protection of said
 County against liability for damages, by reason of the construction,
 maintenance and operation of the same.
