## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, has heretofore passed a Resolution authorizing the submission to the voters of this County, on July 9, 1940, the question as to whether or not a one mill extra levy should be made under the provision of Article 10, Section 10, of the Oklahoma Constitution, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1940, for the purpose of constructing public buildings, and a calk of said election has been made, and

WHEREAS, today is the day fixed by law for the filing of the estimate of needs, and

WHEREAS, a one mill extra levy will raise the sum of \$114,500.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the estimate of needs of Tulsa County shall be and is hereby made to include an item of \$114,500.00 for the purpose of erecting public buildings in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, for the use and benefit of the Tulsa County Agricultural and Industrial Exposition and Fair, and the Tulsa County Highway Department, and for other public purposes; and the Chairman of the Board is authorized and directed to file with the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, an estimate of needs setting forth the item above mentioned.
