

bring the benefits of the A & M College, the State Experiment Stations, and the United States Department of Agriculture to the farmers of this County, and for the purpose of encouraging farmers and their families to make the best of all available opportunities, and for the particular encouragement of boys' and girls' club work.

TERM OF AGREEMENT:

The said Tulsa County agrees to co-operate with the Extension Division of the Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical College and the United States Department of Agriculture in conducting Agricultural and Home Economics extension work in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, during the year beginning July 1, 1928, and ending June 31, 1929.

METHOD OF PROCEDURE:

For the objects expressed above, the Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical College, co-operating with the United States Department of Agriculture shall select the Agent or agents to be employed, such persons to be well qualified to fill these positions by training, education and experience, who shall be satisfactory to the Commissioners of the said County.

COUNTY FUNDS:

The County Commissioners agree to pay Two Hundred Twenty Five Dollars (\$225.00) per month on the salary of a County Agricultural Agent, and One Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$120.00) per month on the salary of a County Home Demonstration Agent for a period of twelve months, beginning July 1, 1928. The County Commissioners further agree to furnish an office and to appropriate the following amounts to apply on the expenses of the County Agent \$1,500.00; for the County Home Demonstration Agent \$1,200.00; for Office Assistant \$1,920.00 for salary or expense of a Negro County Agent \$____; for salary or expenses of a Negro Woman Agent \$____; the expenses to be paid monthly and the total amount paid in one month not to exceed the proportionate part of the year the agent has worked.

COLLEGE FUNDS AND EQUIPMENT.

In addition to the funds furnished by the County, the Extension Division of the Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical College, co-operating with the United States Department of Agriculture will pay One Hundred Ten Dollars (\$110.00) per month on the salary of the County Agricultural Agent, and will pay one Hundred Ten Dollars (\$110.00) per month on the salary of the Home Demonstration Agent, also will pay \$____ per month on the salary of an Assistant Agent; also will pay \$____ on the salary of a Negro County Agent, and \$____ on the salary of a Negro Woman Agent. The Extension Division of the A & M College also agrees to furnish all agents employed with the franking privilege for the free use of the mails in sending of agricultural publications in the County, to furnish the agents necessary stationery, instructions and printed bulletins for the use of farmers in the County, both from the College and from the United States Department of Agriculture.

SUPERVISION:

The Extension Division of the Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical College also agrees to supervise the work of these agents, carefully looking after the same to see that the work is done efficiently and in a manner to be of the largest possible benefit to the people of the County, and to pay the expenses of the Agents when they are authorized to attend any meetings outside of the
