

Order to Gulf Pipe Line

Office Of The Board Of County Commissioners Tulsa Co. State of Oklahoma
 Now on this 5 day of October 1908, at a regular meeting held in compliance of and according to law of said Board of County Commissioners comes the Gulf Pipe Line Company and presents to the Board its request in writing, setting forth that it is necessary for the purpose of carrying on its business of purchasing and transporting crude petroleum, as in said petition stated, to lay, construct and maintain lines of pipe and telegraph or telephone wire along and across the public highways of said Tulsa County and said Board being fully advised in the matter and having carefully considered the same, it is hereby ordered that the said Gulf Pipe Line Company be and it is hereby permitted to lay, maintain and operate lines of pipe and telegraph or telephone wire for the conveyance of crude oil along and across any of the public highways in said Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, where the same may be necessary for the construction of its said lines of pipe.

It is further ordered that said lines of pipe shall be buried so as not to interfere with ingress or egress to adjacent farms at the ordinary places of entrance and at such other places along such highways where the abutting land-owners may desire to locate a place for entrance when so requested by said owner.

It is understood that in granting this order that it shall in no way be construed as assuming any responsibility on the part of the Board of County Commissioners of said Tulsa County, or on the part of said County, but the Gulf Pipe Line Company shall be responsible for all damages done in constructing said lines of pipe, or which in any wise may be caused or occasioned thereby or by the use of the same hereafter.

It is further understood and agreed that said lines of pipe shall be used only for the transportation of crude petroleum. It is further understood, and agreed that this order and the rights secured and granted thereby shall in no wise abridge the right and authority of the County Commissioners, the Township Trustees and the Road Overseers of the public highways in said County, as the same is now provided by law.

It is further ordered that said lines of pipe, telegraph or telephone wires shall be so laid and constructed so as not to interfere with the use of any of the said public highways nor the repairs thereof. When pipe, telegraph or telephone lines parallel section lines they shall be laid and constructed as near the outside line of highways as possible and in no case shall they encroach on the inside line of the highway more than three feet, without first getting permission from the County Commissioners so to do. It is further ordered that said line of pipe shall be laid and constructed so as not to interfere with the drainage of the highways, and in

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
