The opinion of County Attorney Malloy, in feference to the legality of the election for March, 17th, was received and the order made a matter of record. (See Exhibit "D".)

Board of County Commissioners,
Tulsa, Oklahoma.
Gentlemen:

The matter of the purchase of the fair grounds by Tulsa County and the issuance of the bonds of the County in payment therefor, has had the consideration of this office.

I find that there is no statute or law authorizing either the purchase of this character of property by a county, nor is there any provision for the calling of an election to vote the bonds of the county in payment therefor. It is a well settled principle of law that the Poard of County Commissioners have no power to act in any matter unless they be given such power by the express provision of the statute. There being no such express provision of law in this instance, the Board of County Commissioners in the opinion of this office, is without authority to call an election for the purpose of voting bonds in order to purchase the Tulsa Fair Grounds property.
