MONDAY, MARCH 1st, 1943.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, March 1st, 1943, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman; Ralsa F. Morley and Curtis Greer, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the Estimate No. 1 on Project No. 8, same being the asphalt paving on 36th Street North, Memorial to U.S. #75, filed by the Amulco Products, Inc., in the amount of \$16,543.52, be and the same is hereby approved and the Chairman is hereby authorized to execute same. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

J. B. Gray, Chairman, deposited on February 23rd, 1943, with the County Treasurer \$100.00 received from B. B. Robinson through Joseph Lantry for work on various streets in Friendly Homes Add. Receipt No. 22074. Same was ordered filed.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that Herman Haiflich be appointed Truck Driver in the County Highway Department at a salary of \$150.00 per month as of March 1st, 1943. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that L. H. Lyon be transferred from caterpillar driver to construction foreman as of March 1st, 1943, at a salary of \$160.00 per month. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
