RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN AND FOR TULSA COUNTY, OKIAHOMA, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE COUNTY ATTORNEY IN AND FOR TULSA COUNTY TO RELEASE A CERTAIN JUDGMENT INSOFAR AS IT EFFECTS LOT 19 BLOCK 2 CRUTCHFIELD ADDITION TO THE CITY OF TULSA, TULSA COUNTY, OKIAHOMA, ACCORDING TO RECORDED PLAT THEREOF

Whereas, a certain lawsuit was filed in District Court of Tulsa County, Oklahoma on April 23, 1926 by Byron Kirkpatrick, County Attorney in and for Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in case No. 35795, wherein W. G. Moore, C. C. Daily and E. F. Peters were named as defendants, and,

WHEREAS, judgment was rendered by said District Court in said suit on January 15, 1927 in the sum of \$1000.00 against defendents, C. C.Daily and E.F. Peters, a copy of which judgment is hereto attached, marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof, and,

WHEREAS, thereafter, said Byron Kirkpatrick, County Attorney, aforesaid, then and there acting, made, executed and filed a certain partial release and satisfaction of judgment in said case, insofar as it effected the following described property, towit:

Lot 19 Block 2 Crutchfield Addition to the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof, and,

a copy of said partial release and satisfaction of judgment being here to attached; marked Exhibit "B" and made a part hereof; and,

WHEREAS, two separate Building and Loan Associations have approved the title by taking montgages upon the above described property, one dated March 24, 1941 for \$1500.00 recorded in Book 1423 Page 7; and the other, dated April 23, 1942 for \$1800.00 recorded in Book 1485 page 614, by the Home Federal Savings and Loan Association of Tulsa, a corporation, and,

WHEREAS, by inadvertence, no authority appears of record by which said Byron Kirkpatrick, acting as County Attorney, released said property from said judgment, and,

WHEREAS, more than sixteen (16) years have elspsed since the rendition of said judgment; and,

WHEREAS, all public officials and officers acting in their official capacity are presumed to do their duty, and,

WHEREAS, Byron Kirkpatrick was an honorable, upright, efficient and just public, trusted official of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and served as County Attorney of said County for many years, and,
