TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 7, 1948

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners met at the hour of 10:00 O'clock A. M., with all members present: Claude W. Bailey, Chairman; Roy Evans and John Couch, Members. William P. Gable, Jr., County Clerk.

Claude W. Bailey, Chairman, presiding, the following official business was transacted:

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Evans, and unanimously carried, that the Memorandum of Agreement for Extension Work between the Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical College and the County Commissioners for carrying on cooperative demonstration work in agriculture and home economics, including 4-H club work in Tulsa County, be and the same is hereby approved.

Motion made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that the following Order be, and the same is hereby approved:

PIPE LINE ORDER

ORDER BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

TULSA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA

Now on this the 7th day of September 1948, the matter of the petition of THE TEXAS EMPIRE PIPE LINE COMPANY, a corporation of the State of Delaware, for permission to lay a pipe line along, under and across certain highways in said County and State came up before the Board of County Commissioners of said county for hearing, and it appearing that it was just that the said The Texas Empire Pipe Line Company be permitted to use as much of the highway as designated by plat filed by said corporation, and according to said description which is as follows, to-wit:

Entering Tulsa County on the West line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 3, Township 18 North, Range 12 East, thence in a Northeasterly direction a distance of approximately  $3\frac{1}{2}$  miles to a point near the center of Section 23, Township 19 North, Range 12 East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

And it further appearing from the petition herein that said pipe line will be so constructed as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highways and will be constructed in accordance with all the rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing same.

Such line shall be cased the entire road right-of-way where it crosses either existing or immediately proposed farm-to-market or actively maintained county roads and buried at least 36 inches beneath the center and 18 inches beneath existing ditches thereof; provided, if such ditches are unusually shallow, the 18-inch depth shall be below normal ditch depth.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the Board of County Commissioners of said County that permission be granted and permission is hereby granted to said THE TEXAS EMPIRE PIPE LINE COMPANY, its successors and assigns to use as much of the highway as above described. Said line to be constructed in accordance with all the rules of the County Commissioners and under the supervision of the County Engineer.

The above order does not apply to any State Highway.
