Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners re-convened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: John H. Miller, Chairman; J. B. Gray and Harry L. Hopkins, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

John H. Miller, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the Abstractor's Bond filed by The Oklahoma Abstract Company in the amount of \$5,000, and made by Central Surety & Insurance Corporation, be and the same is hereby approved. All members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

John H. Miller, Chairman, deposited on December 8th, 1938, with the County Treasurer \$12.00 collected from Mrs. Gwin for lights, water and gas for the months of October and November. Receipt No. 18228.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the bid made by Frank F. Smith on the NW NW NE Sec. 12-20-13 and SE SW SE less 1.30 acres, for the reason that said amount is not sufficient Sec. 27-20-13, for the sum of \$160.00, be and the same is hereby rejected. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Miller, duly elected Constable, in the amount of \$1,000 and made by the United States Fidelity & Guaranty Company, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

VanZandt, Justice of the Peace, in the amount of \$1,000, and made by the United States Fidelity & Guaranty Company, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the bond of Hal Turner, duly elected Justice of the Peace, in the amount of \$1,000, and made by the National Surety Corporation, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
