

south half of the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of said section 3, and all the part of said Section 3 lying south of the north line of the said Sand Springs Railway right of way in the southwest quarter of said section/^{three} and all that part of said section south of the south line of the Sand Springs Railway right of way, but including that part of lot 7, Section 2, lying between the south line of the Sand Springs Railway right of way, and a diagonal line drawn from the southeast corner of said lot 7, to the northwest corner of said lot 7, all in Township nineteen (19) north, Range twelve (12) East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma;" and

WHEREAS, said petition sets forth the necessity for the drain, a general description of the proposed drainage ditch, the starting point, route and terminus thereof, and that it is the desire to issue bonds to meet the expenses incident to the construction of said ditch; and

WHEREAS, there was filed with said petition a bond in the sum of One Hundred Fifty Dollars, being Fifty Dollars for each mile of said proposed ditch, signed by one of said petitioners, with two good and sufficient sureties, payable to the State of Oklahoma, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses if said petition is denied for and cause Now, Therefore;

BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TULSA COUNTY, STATE OF OKLAHOMA.

1. That said board does hereby find and declare:

That said petition is signed by five or more residents of said county, who claim to be affected by and subject to assessment for the construction of the drainage ditch herein-after indicated.

That the lands to be embraced in such district will be benefited by such drainage; that such drainage ditch will be conducive to and will benefit the public health of the inhabitants of said district, of benefit to the agricultural interest thereof, of benefit to the soil of the lands affected, and that such improvement will be of public utility and benefit.

2. That the bond filed with such petition is signed by one of the said petitioners and is sufficient, and the same is hereby approved.

3. That F. M. Rodolf, Jno. H. Miller, J. S. Shaver, three disinterested residents ^{Tulsa} freeholders of said county, not interested in the construction of the work and not of kin to any person interested therein, be and are hereby appointed viewers to view the line of said proposed ditch and report in writing to this Board whether the said ditch is practicable and necessary, and of public utility and benefit, and, if said ditch is practicable and necessary and of public utility and benefit, to report and recommend in writing the best route for said proposed ditch, whether any portion shall be covered or bridged, and whether the work of construction thereof shall be let by allotment to the several parties interested or let by contract without allotment.

4. That the County Clerk of said county give notice of their appointment to each of said appraisers.

5. That the territory affected by said ditch, if constructed, shall be known and designated Park View Drainage District No. _____.

6. That the Hughes Engineering Company of Tulsa, Oklahoma, assist the viewers hereby appointed.
