C O N T R A C T.

This Contract made and entered into this 2nd. day of July, 1923, by and between Klingel Furniture & Undertaking Co., Undertakers and Embalmers, License No. 261, of Vinita, Oklahoma, party of the first part, and Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, at this time composed of Ed.W.Hedgecock, W.L.North and J.S.Shaver, party of the second part. WITNESSETH:

Party of the first part agrees to bury all the bodies of paupers from Tulsa County of Oklahoma, who are or may hereafter be inmates of the East.Oklahoma Hospital for the Insane of Vinita, Oklahoma, in the following manner to-wit:

Furnish grave, paupers coffin or casket, lined and trimmed, outside box, underclothes and hose and burial robe.

For and in consideration of which the party of the 2nd. part agrees to pay the party of the 1st. part the sum of \$25.00 for each burial.

It is agreed by and between the parties hereto that this contract shall begin on the 2nd. day of July, 1923, and end on the 2nd. day of July, 1923. And first party further agrees that when it shall become necessary to hold a body, for the purpose of communication with relatives or persons interested in same, he will embalm said body free of charge to said second party.
