In the matter of the complaint of the Magic Amusement Company by its Receiver for correction of erroneous assessment:

The above matter came on for hearing on the 3rd day of January, 1938, upon the complaint and affidavit heretofore filed by the Receiver for the Magic City Amusement Company for the correction of erroneous assessments on Lots 4, 5 and 6, in Block 144, in the Original Town, now City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the years 1933, 1935 and 1936, and the same being a regular day of the January session of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and there being present John H. Miller, Chairman, J. B. Gray, Commissioner, and H. L. Hopkins, Commissioners, and on motion of J. B. Gray which motion was seconded by H. L. Hopkins it is duly moved and seconded that the complaint and affidavit for correction of erroneous assessments against the property above mentioned for the years as stated above be denied, and upon said motion having been so made said motion was duly carried. It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, that the complaint and affidavit of erroneous assessments of Lots 4, 5 and 6, in Block 144 in the Original Town, now City of Tulsa, for the years 1933, 1935 and 1936 on the above described property be and the same is hereby denied to which ruling of the Commissioners the petitioner the Receiver for the Magic City Amusement Company excepts and gave notice of his intention to appeal to the District Court of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by J. H. Egbert, Glenpool, covering real estate for the years 1930, 1931 and 1932, be and the same is hereby approved and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue a certificate of error covering same. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by T. M. Marshall covering real estate for the year 1932, be and the same is hereby approved and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue a certificate of error covering same. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by Mrs. J. W. Fitcher for the estate of Emma J. Wilson, covering real estate for the year 1932, be and the same is hereby approved and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue a certificate of error covering same. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
