Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the resignation of Wesley Summers, Constable District 2, be and the same is hereby accepted. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that W. C. (Buck) Fields, be and hereby appointed Constable in District No. 2, replacing Wesley Summers who resigned. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the bond filed by W. C. (Buck) Fields, Constable District No. 2, in the amount of \$1,000.00 and made by the Maryland Casualty Company, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the resignation of Oliver Hodge, County Superintendent of Public Instruction of Tulsa County, effective January 13, 1947, be and the same is hereby accepted. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the report filed by Emile F. Sterger, Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas, for the month of December, 1946, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the bond filed by Leslie Guy Ferguson, Superintendent of Public Instruction of Tulsa County, in the amount of \$1,000.00 and made by the United States Fidelity and Guaranty Company, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the bond filed by E. S. Orman and Florence Orman, doing business as Orman House Movers, in the amount of \$2,500.00 and made by the National Surety Corporation, covering damage to any roads and bridges of Tulsa County, resulting from moving houses and heavy machinery across the Highways, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
