THURSDAY, MARCH 12, 1914.

The Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, met in their rooms in special session at 3:30 o'clock P. M., pursuant to call. (See original call on file in the office of the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma). All members present.

The matter of the Bond Election called for March 17, 1914, was taken up for consideration, and same was generally discussed by petitioners, attorneys representing petitioners, and the Board of County Commissioners.

Moved by Mr. Baker that the call for bond election on March 17, 1914, calling for the issuance of \$50,000.00 bonds for the purchasing of buildings owned by Local Board of Control of the International Dry Farming Congress and Soils Product Exposition, and the Grounds of the Tulsa County Fair Association, be revoked. Seconded by Mr. Wooley. Upon roll call the following vote was given:
