The following Resolution was introduced by Commissioner Gray, who moved its adoption; said motion being seconded by Commissioner Hopkins. Chairman ordered the Resolution read.

R E S O L U T I O N

DIRECTING THE COUNTY TREASURER OF TULSA COUNTY TO TRANSFER FROM THE COUNTY HIGHWAY FUND THE AMOUNT OF \$13,387.14 IN ADDITION TO THE FIVE PERCENT AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

WHEREAS, it is deemed to the best interests of Tulsa County that there be placed in the Sinking Fund and out of the Highway Fund, the sum of \$13,387.14 and that the same be placed in the Sinking Fund out of the 1936-1937 collections from automobile license and gasoline excise tax received from the State of Oklahoma for the Highway Department of Tulsa County in addition to the statutory requirement.

AND WHEREAS, the St. Louis-San Francisco Railroad Company has protested Tulsa County Highway Fund for the years of 1933-34 and 1934-1935 in the amount of \$13,387.14 and said protest is still in effect, and the St. Louis-San Francisco Railroad Company has agreed that if Tulsa County will cause to be placed in the Sinking Fund for the year of 1936-1937 the like amount of \$13,387.14 in addition to the statutory requirement, that they will cause said protest to be dismissed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners will estimate for the Sinking Fund requirement an amount equal to the \$13,387.14 for the year 1936-1937 in addition to the amount required by law to be estimated to be received in the Sinking Fund from automobile license and gasoline excise tax.
